Read and follow the following instructions before starting your online application

Step 1: Apply Online

- A. A candidate may apply for **three** Hons subjects and **two** General courses depending upon his/her eligibility. Please see **Eligibility** criteria before applying courses.
- B. **First click on “ONLINE REGISTRATION” menu and fill up your personal information & academic details.**
- C. Get your **USER ID AND PASSWORD** in your mobile.
- D. Click on “**APPLY ONLINE**” menu and log in using **USER ID and PASSWORD (to be sent to your mobile no. and keep it for future use)** and select Hons & General course for application.
- E. Modify personal & academic details if necessary and apply in your desired courses, upload scan copy of Caste /PH certificate (for SC/ST/OBC-A&B/PH candidate) (within 200 KB) and HS mark sheet (within 200 KB) and finally submit the data.
- F. **To Pay Application Fees (Rs. 200/- for Hons and Rs. 100/- for General course)**
Pay online at any time using Debit/Credit cards, Net banking, wallets, IMPS within specified dates (see **Important Dates**). You will get SMS of fees payment after 2-3 working days of your payment.
- G. Please take print out of application payment receipt and preserve it for future references.
- H. If you need any correction in the submitted form, please click on “**CORRECTION OF SUBMITTED FORMS**” menu and correct & apply.
- I. **Candidates are not required to submit any documents to the college.**
- J. Candidates applied for Honours/General Courses are requested to wait for publication of Merit in college website and college notice board.

Step 2: Steps to be followed after publication of Merit List

- a) 1st Merit Lists along with list of entire applicants will be displayed on College Notice Board and Website on the date notified.
- b) Only Selected candidate in the 1st merit list will click on the link of admission fees payment to pay admission fees within stipulated date. Using **USER ID**,

APPLICATION ID and PASSWORD, candidate will have to log in and Pay admission fees by online mode only within stipulated date. (See **Online Counseling** for details).

- c) 2nd Merit list will be published on College Notice Board and Website on the notified date.
- d) Only Selected candidate in the 2nd merit list will click on the link of admission fees payment to pay admission fees within stipulated date. Using **USER ID, APPLICATION ID and PASSWORD**, candidate will have to log in and Pay admission fees by online mode only within stipulated date.
- e) **This process will continue until all seats are filled up and if any candidate fails to pay his/her admission fees within stipulated date and time; his or her candidature will be cancelled.**

Step 3: Steps to be followed after payment of admission fees (Date of Activation of link for downloading Registration form will be notified later)

- a) Log in using **USER ID, APPLICATION ID and PASSWORD** and **upload your photo, signature and HS admit card**. Take print out of your application form and registration form.
- b) Printed Registration Form and Application Form (consisting Photo and signature of the candidate) with other requisite documents are to be submitted in college office on the stipulated date to get the **Roll No. with Fees Book, Temporary Library Card and Identity Card**.
- c) **Taking Roll no. on stipulated date is mandatory failing of which the candidature will be cancelled.**
- d) **Students, already enrolled in another College, should get their Admission cancelled from the previous college, before getting Admission.**

N.B.

- a) **The admission is provisional, subject to scrutiny and verification of the documents submitted.** The provisional admission is liable to be cancelled if student fails to submit documents required by the University. If admission of any such student is not approved by the University, she/he will not be entitled to any refund of fees.
- b) **Selection will be strictly on the basis of merit.**
- c) **It is assumed that the information furnished in the application is true to the best of the knowledge of the applicant. In case of any false / misleading information, the application will be summarily rejected.**
- d) **It is also assumed that the applicant is applying voluntarily on his / her own discretion without being influenced by any third party.**
- e) **The college authority reserves the rights of admission / rejection of any applicant without assigning any reason whatsoever.**
- f) In case of fraudulent activities / misconduct, observed even at a later stage, a candidate / student may be debarred from the college at the sole discretion of the College Authority and legal action may be initiated.

Eligibility:

For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the Honours / General Course, **aggregate marks** shall be calculated by adding the marks in top-four subjects in order of marks secured by a candidate. However, marks in compulsory Environmental Education/ Studies (ENVE) shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. If the subject “Environmental Science” is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Vocational examination conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education and Skill Development shall be eligible to seek admission to the B.A. (General) only. Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Vocational Examination in Business & Commerce conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education and Skill Development shall be eligible to seek admission to the B.Com. (General) 1st year Course of Studies under this University.

The students who have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent Examination in 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017 are eligible for admission.

Pass in a subject means 30% marks in both theory and practical (if applicable).

- Candidates who willing to take **Microbiology** as combination subject, must pass in **Biology/ Bio-Technology and Chemistry/ Physics** in H.S. (10+2) examination.
- Candidates who willing to take **Education** as combination subject, must pass in **Psychology/Philosophy/Mathematics/Sociology/Economics/Political Science/History** in H.S. (10+2) examination.

Merit Index Calculation

For Honours Course

- a) Merit-list of all Honours subjects will be framed on the basis of **aggregate percentage of Best Four marks (Except ENVE) + percentage of subject marks opted for Honours** obtained in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.

For General Course

- a) Merit-list of all **General Course** will be framed on the basis of **aggregate percentage of Best Four marks (Except ENVE)** obtained in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.
- b) Merit List for **Computer Science** as Combination subject will be based on **aggregate percentage of Best Four marks (Except ENVE) + percentage of marks in Mathematics + percentage of marks in Physics** obtained in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.
- c) Merit List for **Geography** as Combination subject will be based on **aggregate percentage of Best Four marks (Except ENVE) + percentage of marks in Geography** obtained in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.
- d) Merit List for **Education** as Combination subject will be based on **aggregate percentage of Best Four marks (Except ENVE) + percentage of marks in Psychology/Philosophy/Mathematics/Sociology/Economics/Political Science/History** obtained in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.
- e) Merit List for **Microbiology** as Combination subject will be based on **aggregate percentage of Best Four marks (Except ENVE) + percentage of marks in Biology/ Bio-Technology+percentage of marks in Chemistry/ Physics** obtained in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.
- The students who have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent Examination-2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017 are eligible for admission. But their merit index (i.e. percentage of Best Four marks and opted Honours subject marks (for Honours course) and percentage of Best Four marks (for General Course)) will be reduced @ 10 % for each preceding year i.e. 10 % marks will be deducted for the candidates who have passed the said examination in the year 2016, 20 % marks will be deducted for the candidates who have passed the said examination in the year 2015 and 30 % for the candidates of 2014 and so on. According to Calcutta University rules, **the candidates who have passed the HS or equivalent examination before 2012 are not eligible for admission.**
 - The Compartmental or C.C candidates are also eligible for admission through online application. But their total marks will be reduced @ 5 % extra for each year of appearance in the said examination.

- The students who will take Geography or Computer Science as a combination subject have to pay Rs. 100 /- per month extra as the laboratory fees.
- The students who will take Education as a combination subject have to pay Rs. 200 /- per month extra.
- The students who will take Micro-biology as a combination subject have to pay Rs. 300 /- per month extra as the laboratory fees.
- **50% concession of fees will be given to the person who are efficient in Cultural activities (having certificate from Govt. approved Academy) and Sports activities (having certificate of participation/medallist in District/State/National level).**

Verification, enrollment and Admission

Following documents are required at the time of verification:

- a) Printed application form (signed by the candidate and his/her guardian) to be signed by the Professor/Officer at the time of checking.
- b) Admit card of the Madhyamik or Equivalent examination in original and two copies self-attested.
- c) Admit card of the H.S. or Equivalent examination in original and one copy self-attested.
- d) Mark-sheet of the Higher Secondary or Equivalent Examination in original and two copies self-attested.
- e) Original and two self-attested copies of S.C/ST/Physically Challenged/OBC Certificate (for SC/ST/OBC/PH candidate) **from the S.D.O./DM in the name of the candidate. If the said certificate from S.D.O./DM is unavailable, he / she will not be entitled to avail the reservation facility.**
- f) 3 copies of recent passport size coloured photograph. (with blue background and 75% of photo occupied by face only).
- g) **If you have been passed from board other than WBCHSE, CBSE, ISC, NIOS, Rabindra Mukta Vidyalaya, Viswa-Bharati, West Bengal, Board of Madrasah Education and WBSCVET, migration certificate is required at time of checking, otherwise your admission will be cancelled.**
- h) Original and two self-attested copies of BPL/Antyadaya card.
- i) Filled-up Id Card form, temporary Library and Id card (to be collected at the time of checking)
- j) **Residue amount of admission fee, if any.**
- k) Printed Registration form (signed by the candidate) **and if you have already registered (in previous year (s)) in any college under Calcutta University, please bring your ORIGINAL along with two copies of Registration Certificates.**
- l) **Transfer certificate if you have already admitted (or previously admitted) in any other college, otherwise your admission will be cancelled.**
- m) **Candidates, who have previously admitted in our college and re-admitted in this year, please take NO DUES CERTIFICATE from our office before Verification; otherwise your admission will be cancelled.**
